



## 2017 Brush “I Need My Teeth” Assembly Evaluation

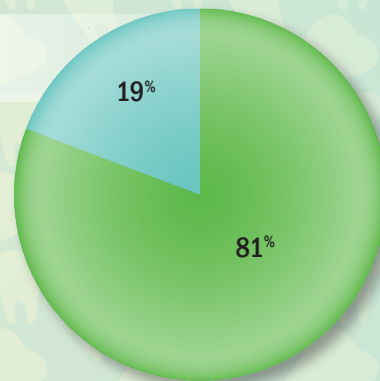


An electronic survey was sent to the teachers who scheduled the Brush “I Need My Teeth” assembly. Twenty-five performances were presented to schools in Michigan, Ohio, and Indiana, grades Pre-K through 5th grade. The assembly was presented to 4,335 students and 346 teachers or other adults.

Results were overwhelmingly positive, with 96% of teachers indicating the assembly was above average or exceeded expectations. **One hundred percent of teachers felt the assembly format was an effective way to teach children about oral health!**

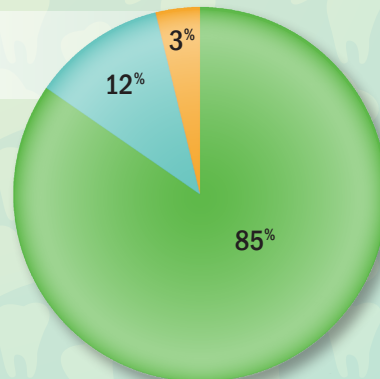
### How was your overall experience with the Brush assembly?

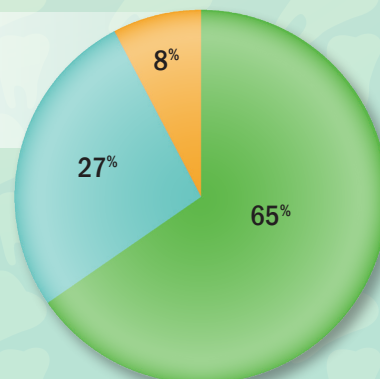
### How was your students' experience with the Brush Assembly?
